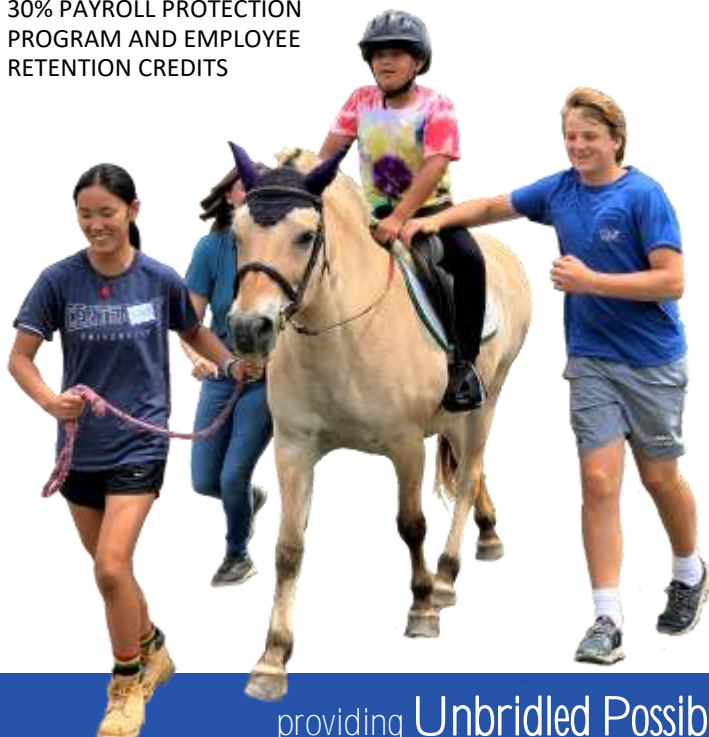

Mane Stream was busy in 2021!

The year started off strong and we kept up the momentum through all of our programs. Always mindful of local pandemic related policies, Mane Stream welcomed 294 participants to the farm during the year, bringing us close to the number we served in 2019. Many volunteers returned and plenty of new volunteers joined the team.

Our adaptive riding program continued to grow, and we celebrated with 2 of our instructors who received their certifications from PATH Intl. The Annual Horse Show was a big hit with our riders. 31 competitors, including 6 volunteers, showed off their riding skills for their friends and families and the event raised a record \$10,000. We implemented a skills tracking and evaluation system for adaptive riding so that we can more closely monitor how riders acquire skills during the year and enabling us to provide periodic progress reports to parents/caregivers.

Summer camp was popular again in 2021 with all 11 weeks totally full within the first month of registration. The 53 campers had a great time learning how to ride, dressing their horses for the weekly costume parade and doing tons of horse related activities.

2021 was also a big year for field trips to the farm including 86 scouts, and the entire 3rd grade from the Far Brook School. Our field trip program is an excellent way for us to introduce more people to our amazing programs. Therapy services saw a slight increase in the number of clients served but, because many of our clients have health challenges, the program remains sensitive to the unpredictability of COVID.

Our generous donors are at the heart of everything that happens at Mane Stream. We rely on the support of our community to serve the hundreds of children and adults with special needs in our programs every year. Gifts of every size make a difference and we are appreciative of all the support Mane Stream received in 2021. Thank you for continuing to invest in Mane Stream's participants!
